How Much Does Membership Cost?

Type of Membership	Cost
Individual – One Year	\$250
Individual – Two Year	\$450 (\$50 savings)
Associate (only available to full-time students, retirees, individuals who are unemployed or on an unpaid leave of absence, and employees of a governmental employer)	\$150
Corporate (at least five members of a single organization, regardless of chapter affiliation)	\$200 (\$50 savings on each membership)
